No. 817)**

1. Each year the Bodies' annual return is audited by an external auditor appointed by the Audit Commission. Any person interested has the opportunity to inspect and make copies of the Annual Return and all books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts etc. relating to them. For the year ended 31st March 2013 these documents will be available on reasonable notice on application (to the address given below) between the hours of 9am and 4.30pm, Monday to Friday commencing on 21st May 2014 and ending on 18th June 2014.
2. Local Government Electors and their representatives have rights to:
 - question the auditor about the accounts; and
 - object to the accounts or any item in them. Written notice of an objection must first be given to the auditor and a copy sent to the Audited body.

The auditor can be contacted at the address in paragraph 3 below for this purpose on 20th June 2014 and until the audit has been completed.

3. The Audited body's audit is being conducted under the provisions of the Audit Commission Act 1998, the Accounts and Audit (England) Regulations 2011 and the Audit Commission's Code of Audit Practice. The audits are being carried out by:
