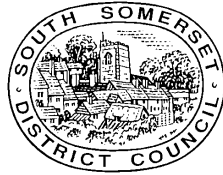

- ✓ All cheques must be made payable to 'South Somerset District Council'
- ✓ Building Control's objective under Building Regulations, Part P is to be reasonably certain that the Electrical Installation is safe, and was properly designed, installed and tested in order to protect persons from fire or injury. Sufficient information must be provided so that persons wishing to operate, maintain or carry out alterations to the installation can do so with reasonable safety.
- ✓ Building Control, or an Approved Electrician (AE) engaged by us will need to inspect the installation at key stages, these stages are;

Before work commences	48 hours notice required	We will expect to see a scheme of the intended works, this could be in the form of a written schedule or diagrammatic. We will also expect to see proof of any calculations to justify cable sizes etc and details of the existing supply, distribution and earthing arrangements
Following first fix	48 hours notice required	We expect to receive any information that was unavailable or requested at the first visit. Access will be needed to show clear routing of cables. If any cables that have been covered before this inspection has taken place you could be requested to expose them at your expense.
Completion	With-in 5 days of completion of the installation	We would expect a copy of BS7671 certificate to be issued to ourselves. Should the installer not be able to issue the certificate the AE will carry out a periodic Test and Inspect on our behalf.
